Eligibility

Applicants for the Aboriginal Youth Leadership course must be Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander Australian living in the Central Australian Region of the Northern Territory. To apply you must be aged between 18 – 30 years of age and be interested in expanding your knowledge about leadership and setting a plan for yourself over the next five years.

Selection and Notification

Selection for the program will be based on first come first served and there are only a limited number of placements available. Successful applicants will be notified by phone and/or email on the **26th of June** and must be able to confirm their attendance upon notification.
